As February kicks off, I would like to welcome Seth Bowker to the staff of FBC. He officially begins his role as part-time associate pastor of FBC on February 1st, and I am excited to see what God is going to do as we begin a new stage in ministry with Seth.

I dongt often concern myself with the hallmark calendar when it comes to preaching. We usually recognize mothers and fathers on Motherøs Day and Fatherøs Day, and veterans on Veterans Day, but I dongt organize the preaching calendar around such observances. This year, however, I am going to spend February preaching about marriage. More so because I see a great need than because it es trendy. Marriage was established by God to reflect His

uary News—Kids Club Ministry



When I was in my early early 20's, I experienced a couple short seasons of doubt in my faith. I would be trucking along doing my normal thing and out of nowhere these questions would rise up within me..."What if God isn't real?", Is he here with me?", and "Am I fooling myself?" I remember distinctly the summer before my senior year in college. I was in my senior internship at a Christian family homeless shelter in Kansas City, MO. I was sitting on the floor of the bedroom I shared at the shelter with another intern, working on a project for an inner-city camp. As I sat their cutting cardstock, I wondered for a moment if all of this was even worth it. In the midst of the pain, apathy, poverty, and desperation of those who I was serving, I wondered for a moment if God was real. It was as if Satan circled around me sitting on that

faded carpet, whispering these doubts in my ear. I stopped what I was doing and thought for a moment. This wasn't the first time I had thoughts like these but I have to say it was my last. I said out loud at that moment (to Satan) that my faith wasn't going to waiver. I was going to choose to believe what the Bible says is true!

Faith is choosing to believe even when we don't have all the answers. In that moment I had victory over Satan's schemes. He doesn't want us to believe that there is a God. He distracts us, tempts us, whispers lies in our ears, and tries to spin us into a completely different direction than where our Creator God desires us to be. God wants us to have hope, purpose, and peace. Satan, on the other hand, is the master of all lies and doesn't want us to have anything but death and destruction. That night as I was sitting on the floor I knew and believed that my hope is and always will be in Jesus! If you think about it, nothing else compares.



If you find yourself asking these questions, I want to encourage you. They're great questions to ask! We need to ask them BUT be careful where you go looking for the answers. The Bible is clear about how our understanding is nothing compared to God's. Science doesn't have it figured out (see Prov. 3:5-6). We have to have faith.

Here are some things you can do and that I myself do when I'm struggling:

- Keep talking to God. Don't stop praying. God wants us to share our heart and thoughts with him. He made you and wants for you to trust him with everything.
- Hebrews 11:6 "And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him."
- Ask God for His peace that only he can give. If you have accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior, you have the Spirit of God living inside of you. **Philippians 4:6-7** "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."
- Keep connected to your Christian brothers and sisters. Keep going to church and signing up for those Bible studies. You're not alone. Let your church family surround you in prayer and love. **Romans 10:17** "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ."
