#### Pastor's Perspective ~ The Unique & the Mundane



We also have a few baptisms coming up right around the corner. We hope you'll join us on Sunday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> to celebrate those baptisms of





Going through all the channels proper and regulations is verv interesting a n d exhausting. The funds are continuing to match the needs and just when I think the budget is at again, someone donates more to help.


