El Salvador was plan B. About seven or eight years ago Jim Earl and I were talking about a mission trip to Nicaragua. Jim had taken a small group there the previous year, and we were going to take another group to Nicaragua the following summer. It just so happened that the week we planned on going wasn't available, so we began discussing other options. Jim said he knew a great missionary in El Salvador named Rigoberto, and maybe we could plan a trip with him. The rest, as they say, is history. I have led 7 groups to El Salvador in the same number of years.

Each trip is a mixture of labor, children's ministry, and fellowship (within our group, and with the great people of El Salvador). Primarily our ministry has been to do a VBS style children's program with a Bible story skit, Gospel presentation, and a craft. We might do anywhere from 5 to 10 events in a In recent years we had the opportunity to do our program in the public schools, which has greatly increased the number of children we've been able to share the Gospel with. On this trip, we estimate nearly 800 children that attended our programs. We have plans to do the program in even more schools next time, which could mean reaching 1,000 kids in a week of ministry.

Our role in this ministry is three-fold:

1) We serve as a conduit between the local pastors/churches and their communities to create a high impact event which enables them to grow churches, and/or start new churches.

- 2) We have deep, personal relationships with the folks in El Salvador which creates fellowship and trust, which allows us to offer financial support year round and know that our support is having an impact.
- 3) Our mission teams are encouraged by the hard work and devotion that the people of El Salvador exemplify, which creates a desire to serve God more and more in our own community.

It's such a joy to see how our church has grown to love missions. I believe it started in the hearts of a few, Jim Earl being the most notable, but has spread like a fire through FBC. I want to thank our church for the grace and generosity that makes this possible. I also want to encourage our church to remember that mission work is just another name for ministry, and ministry is another name for serving God. Please don't think that you have to travel 3,000 miles to serve God. The kingdom of God is built by countless people doing seemingly menial things. One of the greatest things about FBC I've come to love is that people care about each other and do whatever is needed. From greeting, parking cars, watching babies, making meals, moving chairs, teaching classes, praying for hurting people, giving money, time, and talent, to virtually anything necessary to help others know Christ. I can't possibly say enough about how great it is to be in a church that loves to be all about God's mission.



A Word From Pastor Seth

Why Church?



I hear "why church" from folks wanting to know why they need to be at a specific time (8am or 10:15am) and place (church building) to talk to God. Not wanting my idea on the matter but simply to show they are right that they can talk to God anytime, anywhere and any moment. It's true you can talk to God anytime and anywhere.... but are you? I too, have spoken those very words "why do I have to go to church when God is everywhere" or "why do I have to go to church to be with God?"

Ephesians 4:11-16 is revealing the question why church.

The spiritual leaders are to equip the saints (Christians) so that they can do the work of ministry. We all have a gift from the Lord that we should be ministering to one another. We dive in to serve each other and edify one another in love. We do all of this in unity through knowing Christ personally and understanding all He did for us. Jesus Christ is the standard of maturity to which the church must aspire. At the same time, God is continually and faithfully working out the image of Christ in each of us, so that we may reflect Jesus to the world. This is coming to maturity, reaching the measure or seeing the fullness of Christ in us.

Church becomes less about the place and time. Church now becomes the **how** and not the **why**. Church is how God transforms, how God shapes and how God uses me in the ministry to reach the world with truth and love about Christ. Christ (head) is leading the Church but without "you" then the body is missing a vital part, a limb, a finger or an internal organ. ~Seth




