I'm really excited about everything coming up, and hopeful for what God is going to do through it all. But busy-ness can be a problem. Some have quoted the phrase that being busy is Being Under Satan's Yoke. I would admit that could be the case. Busy-ness is a problem when we fill our lives with things that distract us from God. Busy-ness becomes satanic when we use it as an excuse to neglect: family, church, Bible reading, prayer, friendships, taking care of ourselves, and the list goes on... Even as busy as we can all potentially be, we have to prioritize important things over "good" things.

There tends to be a sense of competition for our time. We face this dilemma all the time at the church. We have events, classes and programs that we believe are really valuable and important, and so we

promote them as best we can to get as possible. much involvement as Sometimes people are so inundated with "good" things to do or be part of that they are pulled in a thousand directions trying to keep up with it all. Inevitably, the result is that so many good things have prevented people from doing the most important things. This is the proverbial Mary vs. Martha syndrome. Martha was busy with lots of good things, while Mary was focused on the most important thing. There is a question that only you can really answer. What is most important in your life? And secondly, what must you do to make sure it's being kept in the highest priority position? The likely answer to the first question is: faith, followed closely by family. The answer to the second question is much more difficult, but it will most likely involve saying no to something less important that is distracting you from Christ, and His plan for your future and your family.

So, if I can encourage you to do something, I'd say this: spend more time in prayer, in the Word, with your family, and less time worrying and running from here to there. Do the things that build your faith, and quit the things that add no value to your life or the well-being of your family. After all, Jesus said: "Seek first His kingdom, and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you as well."
