~ Acts 9:15b

You are a chosen instrument in the hands of Almighty God. I have absolutely no hesitation in saying this. We are created in His image, deeply loved, persistently sought after, and sacrificially and highly paid for, not to mention greatly valued. No matter who might ever read those sentences; whether rich, poor, young, old, successful, down and out, highly educated, mentally disabled, repentant sinner, or rebellious sinner, or any other possible human identity that exists, those statements are true and applicable to you. It's God's definition of who we are as human beings, not what we've done or how we feel about ourselves that matters. The only thing that makes the difference in any of our lives is very simply whether or not we will agree with God, or go to our grave rejecting Him.

Once we've heard the good news (Christ died for you and faith in Him is the source of all healing and forgiveness), trusted Him for salvation, then the next step is to make ourselves available for God's good and wonderful purpose in our lives. Our lives automatically are infused with eternal purpose and meaning. The question will come; what is God's will for my life ...? At this point I would refer you back to the Scriptures I referenced above. Three things are important to take notice of:

- 1) You are a chosen instrument. The instrument is most useful in the hands of a skillful worker, namely Christ.
- 2) Christ is wise, and prefers to work with sharp instruments. If the instrument is dull, the work is much harder (and harder the on instrument!).
- 3) Christ sharpens His instruments using other instruments.

I was working on a little project where I needed to cut a metal doorframe. I had a wonderful little tool Seth let me borrow for the job. I hacked away at the first door frame for a long time, and thought this was going to take forever, and maybe the tool wasn't so great after all. Then I put a new blade on the tool. The job was done in two minutes... The little saw cut like a hot knife through (cold) butter (I was still cutting through metal after all). It made me think about each of us. How sharp of an instrument am I in my Master's hand? Am I allowing myself to be sharpened by those around me? When I'm sharp, Christ can use me, but when I'm dull more strength is needed. What about you? How is God sharpening you? Will you let Him? Will you let the Word of God transform your mind? Will you let godly council inform your decisions? Will you let difficult relationships teach you about perseverance and forgiveness? Will you let tough situations strengthen your faith? If you'll do these things, you'll see what wonderful things God can create, shape, remodel and produce with your life in His hands.







What better way is there to show love for someone than to commit to pray for them? On the first Sunday of each



Quest is a fun filled weekend for fathers and sons. These father son adven-




### "Pilgrim's Progress" by John Bunyon **Copies available in the church lobby.** Cost-\$13

This month's book is Pilgram's Progress John Bunyan (1628–1688) was a Reformed Baptist preacher in the Church of England. He is most famous for his celebrated *Pilgrim's Progress*, which he penned in prison. Bunyan was author of nearly sixty other books and tracts, including The Holy War and Grace Abounding to the Chief of Sinners. — For more than three centuries both Christians and non-Christians, young and old, have been fascinated by the characters and story of John Bun-

yan's The Pilgrim's Progress. In this breathtakingly beautiful edition of Bunyan's classic, updated in today's language, the characters are brought to life in color images taking you on a visually stunning journey with Christian as he seeks the Celestial City. When you encounter Evangelist, Hypocrisy, Faithful, and others, you'll better understand life's joys and sorrows on this side of heaven.

### **Blessing Box Update!**


As most of you know, First Baptist has a Blessing Box in our north parking lot. This is a mini food pantry that people can access any time of the day or night. 
