
# The Refuge Student Ministry

Denise and I recently went through an indepth training seminar called "Caring for the Heart Ministries" located in Colorado. Through this intensive training we both learned wonderful tools in Biblical Counseling. I'm excited to bring these tools back to the Church and use them to help others. Our chairman of the deacons, Jon said "It is one thing to have cool tools and the next thing is to learn to use cool tools" and I realized how right his statement is in every area of our life.

#### Men's Momentum Weekend Is Oct. 18th—20th, 2019 Buchanan, MI at Life Action Camp-Cost for Momentum is \$100






