When we were in El Salvador in March I heard a term that I had never heard before. We were just starting to get news about how the Corona Virus was impacting the United States. One of the mission team members works for Walmart, and they found out that Walmart had cancelled their national conference. The term that was being used was "social distance". With thousands of people in a convention center, "social distance" couldn't be managed. Now, we don't like the term "social distance," so we try to say "physical distance." In either case, it's a term we are all too familiar with, and at least as far as I'm concerned, tired of.

There are several words I'm tired of. I'm tired of the words "unprecedented" and "cancelled." Unfortunately, as tired of those words as we might be, it remains a reality that they are still very much in play. The month of August is always an exciting time at First Baptist as we plan our biggest event of the year, "Praise in the Park."
