If you've been attending First Baptist for more than a few years, you know that we have a strong partnership with Life Action Ministries. We utilize their camp in Michigan multiple times each year for family camp, men's retreats, women's retreats, and father/son retreats. We've had revival teams come here to lead weeks of services every few years as well, which they call a Summit. We were planning on hosting another Summit this month, but due to the situation with coronavirus concerns, we thought it best to reschedule. Hosting the Life Action team has been postponed, but our need and desire for revival/refreshing has not. We are thirsty for God. 
