

## Pastor's Perspective

"So is it with the resurrection of the dead... sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory."

~ 1 Corinthians 15:42-4

Throughout the month of March, I preached a series of sermons that outlined the last 24 hours of Jesus leading up to His sacrificial death, from the garden to the cross. Through the month of April, we will be focusing our attention on the risen Christ, from the tomb to glory. He appeared for 40 days before He ascended to the right hand of the Father, and later we see His glory revealed in the book of Revelation by the Apostle John.

It was hope that motivated our Lord to do all that He did. He knew He would be raised to glory and be crowned King of Eternity, but that hope wasn't His motivation. He had eternal glory before the creation of the world. Glory was His rightful aspect. Philippians tells us that he put aside His glory to become lowly. He humbled Himself and took on human form, and submitted to a shameful death. It would be a mistake to think He did all that for His own glory. He did all that so we could share in His

glory. Not only do we look forward to eternal life and a glorified resurrected body, but we glorify Jesus in our daily lives. He has millions of representatives all over the world. Every workplace and community is blessed with a personal ambassador of Christ. You and I represent Jesus everywhere we go in every interaction we have. Some of the ways we do this are:

**Character** – Speaking the truth in love, be honest and dependable. *Ephesians 4:15* 

**Purity** – Disengage from conversations and situations that are not pleasing to God. 2 Corinthians 6:17 & 1 Peter 1:16

**Forgiveness** – Be unwilling to hold a grudge, become bitter or resentful. Apply the grace you've received by God to others. *Matthew 6:14*


