Pastor's Perspective

Go... make disciples... baptize... teach them to obey... I am with you till the end... ~ Jesus, i.e. Great Commission.

The church is always doing several things simultaneously. We are always reaching out with the Gospel, as well as teaching people how to follow God, caring for those who are hurting, worshiping, supporting missions, and about a dozen other things. It mainly boils down to two things: evangelism and discipleship. Those two things boil down further to one thing: worship. We worship (honor, glorify, thank, praise, delight in) God, and we help others to do the same as best we can. This creates a small problem. Since we are always seeking to bring new people into this relationship, while helping everyone to grow toward maturity, we constantly have people from one end of the spectrum to the other. We have non-believers coming to see and hear what this is about, new believers who trust Jesus, but don't know Father Abraham from Abraham Lincoln, and mature believers at various stages of their walk. This is how it is and how it should be. If we had a church full of mature Christians we would be failing to reach out. If we had a church full of baby-Christians, we would be failing to teach and disciple. It's always a mixture. Some things that we do, or events that we plan, are focused more heavily on one of these aspects than another.

In the upcoming month we have some exciting things we're planning. Praise in the Park is scheduled for August 22nd from 10am till 3pm. It's going to be a blast! We hope you'll not only plan on coming, but invite some friends and family to join us. This is an outreach event. It's intended to attract people from the community who don't have a church they call home. We hope it builds up the reputation of Christ and our church and encourages people to come back to hear more. September we are hosting a four-day revival led by Life Action Ministries. This event is intended to help people go deeper. We encourage visitors to join us, and hope that you'll invite friends and family to this wonderful week of revival, but our hope and our aim is that our church body will set aside these days to go deeper with God. It's a wonderful, intensive time of spiritual growth for all. If you're new to First Baptist or new to the Christian faith, this is something you'll definitely not want to miss. We have had Life Action come to FBC many times over the years, and we always hear countless stories of how great an impact it has made in people's lives. September 12th-14th will be the days you'll want to make sure you have your evenings free. Please pray for Praise in the Park, that God would use it to reach many new people in our community, and pray for Life Action Revival, that God would meet us in new and powerful ways as we grow together. In all, we give God the glory for what He's doing in our church. Thanks for being part of it.




Praise In The Park Family Fest is Coming to Aledo's Central Park! Sponsored by First Baptist Church Aledo


Other Sunday School Updates
