Pastor's Perspective

"Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord." \sim Acts 3:19-20

In just a couple weeks Life Action Ministries will be rolling into Aledo. Even though we've had Life Action lead revival services many times over the years, this may be the first time for many people to experience a Life Action Conference. Life Action is a ministry that sends out teams of people, many of which are college aged young people, who have committed at least a year to serve the Lord. They will take over almost every aspect of our ministry for the week they are with us. Starting on Sunday morning, they will lead the worship services and do all the kids ministry from 3 years old up through high school. They will return for worship services and youth and kids programming each night from Sunday night through Wednesday night.

It seems like a big commitment to set aside 4 nights in a row for church, but every single time Life Action comes I hear so many people saying they were not ready for it to end. You won't want to miss a single night. If, for some reason, your schedule won't allow you to come every night, I hope you'll come as many nights as possible. God has big plans for that week, and I know many people are going to get a refreshing sense of God's presence through this experience.

Before they get here, we want to get ready, so I'll be preaching on Revival on September 5th to prepare our hearts for the week to come, and we will also have a special prayer and praise night on Wednesday September 8th. The prayer and praise nights are always a fantastic time of worship and prayer. The theme for the prayer and praise night is "Getting Ready for Revival", so we will have some inspiring worship interspersed with intentional times of prayer.

September is a big month this year. The following Sunday after Life Action has been here, we are planning "Back to Church Sunday". We are inviting everyone we know to get back to church. If you've been missing church for one reason or another, or have been thinking about attending church for the first time, September 19th is the week to put on your calendar. On that Sunday, I'll be starting a new sermon series on the Life of King David, as well as starting a new Discipleship Sunday School class. It's going to be a great day!

There's a lot going on in September, but it's God's plans that prevail. Let's make sure we leave room for what God's going to do in it all.




Tanner's Apple Orchard Outing

What is Wednesday Night Live?



Kids Club kids will be diving into the gospels with Gospel Project, playing games, engaging in activities, making friends, enjoying yummy snacks, and having lots of fun on theme nights. Your kids won't want to miss learning all about Jesus and his life as a kid.

The Refuge Student Ministry on Wednesdays is for students 6th-8th grade. High School students are invited to attend the adult WNL classes. 
