However, when I thought about my family, I had a hard time imagining their life without me. Well, I got the CT scan and was told I had a blood clot in my lung and needed to be admitted to the emergency room. I tried to get them to give me a blood thinner and let me go home, but they protested.

All in all, I am doing fine. In fact, I am extremely grateful. People often say that you don't know how you'll handle certain situations until you experience them. How strong is your faith really? I minister to many people who are facing death, seeking to offer peace through faith in Christ. I was encouraged to know just how very real and present that peace is in my own life. I am grateful for more time. How much more, no one knows. Whatever time I have, I plan to enjoy and use wisely. And I'm grateful for everyone around me. I'm blessed with an awesome family, a great church, and dependable coworkers. I'm looking forward to a wonderful Christmas season, and happy new year.

As we enter the Christmas season I will begin a new preaching series on the life of Christ. We will explore His life through the Gospels from birth to resurrection, beginning December 12<sup>th</sup>, and concluding Easter Sunday.

# It is time to sign up for the 2022 Women's Small Group Program!



The 2022 Women's Small Group program runs from February to October. Groups will be going through "Better Together: A Guide for Discipleship," which will guide you through beginning a discipleship relationship and provide material for you to walk through together as you pursue spiritual maturity. The content covered includes sections on what is discipleship, how to articulate a personal testimony, sharing the Gospel with others, how to study the Bible, how to memorize Scripture and cultivating a life of prayer. The goal of discipleship is ultimately that Christians would use these intentional relationships to flourish in the faith, love God more and seek to glorify Him with their whole lives. We hope you will join us on this journey together!

Small groups decide when, where and how often they meet, though our recommendation is at least once a month. There are options available online when you register to decide if you would like to be placed in a small group, if you are already in a small group that is continuing to meet, or if you would like to form your own small group with some ladies God has placed on your heart. All women, even those currently in a small group need to register, as this will help us know how many materials to order.

Registration begins Dec. 5<sup>th</sup>. The deadline to register is January 9th. Then you will receive information on who is in your group (if applicable) and how to pick up your books in time to begin in February. 


#### **Christmas & New Year's Office Hours**




### What is Wednesday Night Live?


WNL is a series of classes & programs for the whole family held at First Baptist. WNL runs from Wednesday, Feb. 2 through April 6th, 2022 each Wednesday night from 6:30-8pm.

We will have **Kids Club** for kids ages 3 years through 5th grade. Kids Club kids will be diving into the gospels with Gospel Project, playing games, engaging in activities, making friends, enjoying yummy snacks, and having lots of fun on theme nights. Your kids won't want to miss learning all about Jesus and his life as a kid.

The Refuge Student Ministry on Wednesdays is for students 6th-8th grade. High School students are invited to attend the adult WNL classes. High School Refuge will continue to meet on Sunday evenings from 6-8pm. Our goal is to make Refuge a safe place for all students to come and be themselves.
