

We are excited to be able to return with a small group of 10 on March 17<sup>th</sup>. We are planning to do three carnivals over the weekend at three different locations. This is very different than what we've done in the past, so it's exciting and a little scary. We were told we could have up to 500 people at each location. It's a little like trying to plan three Praise in the Park events... Mollie is in charge of most of the logistics, so it'll be well organized. Pray for our team as we work together with Rigo to share the gospel with the people of El Salvador.




#### March 2nd 6:30-8pm





### Room To Grow/Baptism Sunday



We own land! It has been an interesting couple of months here at First Baptist. In mid-December we learned that the farmland across the street from the church was going up for auction. It was a quick turnaround, but we were able to get church approval to bid on the property. By the grace of God, we won the bid, and became the grateful owners of an additional 38 acres to our current 3.5 acres. On February 18th we officially closed on the sale of the property. To be honest, all of that seems like the easy part. Now we have to make some big decisions. 38 acres seems like a lot more room than we currently need, which is true. We didn't have a choice in that number of acres up front since that was how the property was divided. What we have been facing for a long time is the need to expand both our building and our parking. Having some space across the road to build a parking lot would free us up tremendously to expand the building. The down-side is that we had to spend our entire building fund to purchase the land, as well as borrow money to make the sale. The decision we have to reach is multi-faceted. Since we believe 38 acres is more than we will need, we have to determine what

we believe is the appropriate amount of land to keep and how much to sell. By another gracious act of God, we have the opportunity to sell what we don't need at the price we paid.

The things that feed that decision are:

#1 – Current building expansion needs.

#2 – Short-term building and parking development.

#3 – Long-term building and parking development.

#4 – Financial considerations, i.e. how quickly can we recoup the cost of purchasing the land as well as raise money to begin a building project.

#5 – Zoning considerations, i.e. if we keep more than 15 acres there is no need to rezone, anything less than 15 acres will need to be rezoned, which affects potential tax liabilities as well as red tape for future development.

#6 - Tax implications.

#7 – Potential future development of the land we sell, i.e. do we need to retain some acreage as a buffer?

As you can see, the decision is not a simple one. Often times when we focus on one issue exclusively it seems the answer is obvious, but when you take everything into consideration as a whole it becomes more complex. We will be discussing it further at the next business meeting in April. Please pray for God's will to be clearly revealed. Pray for the church leaders to make wise and discerning recommendations. Pray for a continued spirit of unity as we move through this exciting process.


