I am so thankful for the staff that works so hard, and the volunteers that spend countless hours serving in every ministry. Kids will show off what they learned all week . Participants are asked to wear their KidsMin shirts and be in the sanctuary for practice at 9am.





Please bring a list with you.



#### Summer Women's Bible Study






### FBC Men's Ministry Archery Tag

#### A Decision Has Been Made!



After a few months of discussion and prayer we voted on how much land FBC should keep. It was a close vote for sure. In fact, it couldn't have been closer... out of 84 votes, 43 were cast in favor of keeping 10 acres, and the remaining 41 votes wanted to keep 15. In the end we all agreed that the Lord had certainly blessed us with the land we need and we made a unanimous vote to accept the decision.

We will begin the process of getting the land surveyed, rezoned and sold in the upcoming weeks. The most immediate issue, once all the legal stuff is finalized, is putting in a parking lot. We have a bid on 1 acre of gravel parking, which came in at about \$42,000. Any and all who would like to help raise money for the parking lot are welcome to make offerings designated for that project. While that is happening the building committee will also continue to work on plans to expand our facilities.

It's an exciting time at First Baptist. As I said and will always say, it's not about land or buildings or parking lots, it's about changed lives. God continues to bless this ministry with changed lives and a growing church. Everything else is just a matter of providing room for God to keep adding to His kingdom. Thanks for all the prayer, support, time and energy you've put in to make this possible.
