On Sunday night Mollie, Cassidy, and I had a good talk about the weekend. The conclusion was that I wanted to take a week for all of us to pray and seek the Lord before we spoke again. After a week of prayer, Cassidy and I spoke again and confirmed that there was a peace about her potential to become our next youth director. The next step is to confirm with the church. If the church council will agree at our next meeting, then we will vote at the July business meeting whether or not to hire Cassidy. If the church votes yes, then Cassidy will join the FBC staff in early August. I want to thank you for being patient throughout this process, especially Seth who has been faithfully serving as our interim youth director for more than two years. I'm looking forward to what God has in store as we keep moving forward.

#### Women's Verse by Verse Bible Study




New Men's Wednesday Study Book of James Begins July 27<sup>th</sup>!
