We are blessed with a great staff and many, many volunteers at First Baptist. Over the past couple years, we have really banded together during some difficult ups and downs to continue to do great ministry. We have been patiently waiting, praying, and serving until such a time as God would reveal the youth director He had in mind for our church. A few weeks ago, I began talking to a young lady who had sent me her resume. It was the first time in the search process that I can say I was genuinely, wholeheartedly positive about a potential candidate. In a couple weeks Cassidy Lainson will be spending a weekend in Aledo so we can all get to know each other better and confirm whether or not God is calling her to FBC to join our staff. On Sunday, June 12th, Cassidy will be joining us for worship and introducing herself. As a way of introduction, I wanted to share a brief excerpt from her call to ministry:

In my own calling to vocational ministry, God has placed on my heart several burdens for His Kingdom which I will strive to fulfill throughout my days on this Earth. The first of these is that of serving in youth ministry. Along with being the first

burden of calling I identified when I made the decision to pursue vocational ministry, this calling is also the one which I see as the most foundational, and is the focus around which all of my other avenues of ministry calling seem to revolve. Since my generation and those after us have demonstrated increasing struggles with things like mental illness, feelings of abandonment and loss, abuse, broken families, and have also seen some of the highest suicide and drug abuse rates ever recorded (verywellmind.com, 2021), it is clear that there is a dire need for caring and present youth ministers to intervene in the lives of today's youth in order to shine the light of Christ into these all-too-broken souls. This passion of mine also stems from how God has brought me through my own struggles with many of these things, and has placed on my heart the desire to use my experience to help other kids still lost in the darkness amidst I once wandered.

You'll be hearing more from and about Cassidy in the weeks to come. In the mean-time, please pray for her and for us as we seek God's will in discerning the call to serve together.

Uncanceled is a blueprint for standing up for the truth of Jesus Christ in a culture that has forgotten how to have respectful conversations. As Phil reminds us, when we embrace the truth that Jesus Christ already paid an enormous debt to cancel our sins, we find a path to redemption, a way to forgiveness, and a means for godly connection.
