We wish her well, and pray that the Lord would open the right door at the right time for her. We also will continue to seek the Lord's will for the person He has in mind to join our team. This may be a good place to let you in on the heart and the intention behind what has been a long process.

Two years ago when Mario decided to step away from leading the youth ministry it was an easy transition to have Seth take over that area of ministry. Seth had already been involved in leading the youth on an interim basis, and is always ready to jump in and serve wherever needed. As the associate pastor he has always been the go-to guy to help pick up the slack. So, the blessing with Seth leading the Youth Ministry is that we have stability. We don't have to be in a big hurry to try to find someone for that position. Yet, we are committed to seeking

the right candidate to take over. The reality is that we went through a difficult and confusing season during the pandemic, and by the grace of God we have come out the other side of it very healthy. Nevertheless, without a youth director we find ourselves short-staffed. We have been working short-staffed for over two years, and that gets exhausting. There is added pressure on everyone as a result. So, we have to be careful. Careful not to let burnout set in. Careful not to become resentful in serving. And still careful not to rush into hiring someone out of a sense of urgency. We continue to prayerfully consider each candidate that comes to light. We believe that the right person is out there, and in God's perfect timing He will bring them on staff at FBC. So, pray for our next youth director. Also, please pray for our youth, pray for Seth, Mollie, Pam and me, as well as all those serving in support roles, like Jenny, Denise, Jordan, and Lindsay. Pray for all those who serve as volunteers on our praise band, prayer team, men's and women's ministry, Sunday school teachers, nursery workers, and in every behind-the-scenes way that makes our church run like a well oiled machine to the glory of Christ. God is moving. We continue to see new people show up every single week, add new members every business meeting, and baptize new believers every month. The fields are white unto harvest, pray for workers. Maybe that means you!










QUEST Father Son Retreat-Buchanan, MI Sept. 30th-Oct. 2nd






WEDNESDAY NIGHT LIVE ADULT CLASSES!

What is Wednesday Night Live?


