You would think that after 20 years of preaching a person might feel like there isn't much more to be said. Strangely enough, the opposite seems to be true. I suppose that shouldn't be surprising because God's Word is inexhaustible. I have enjoyed the series we just concluded about the Apostle Paul. Many more messages could be preached on the details of his life and ministry, but I think it is time to move on. As I was praying and considering what we should study next, I had many things on my mind. In October we will begin a series on Discipleship. The first message on this topic will actually be given by Bill Allison, who leads a ministry called Cadre Missionaries. He has dedicated his life and ministry to teaching and training on this particular issue of discipleship and helping Christians become disciple makers. So, he will give the message on October 2nd, and then lead a discipleship workshop on Saturday October 8th. This event is sponsored

by the FBC Men's Ministry, but we hope to have a huge turnout from our whole church body. So, for the month of September, I considered some different topics I could preach on and I asked myself a question. What do people need right now? I've mentioned at least a couple times that we seem to be experiencing a pandemic of depression and despair. If nothing else, many people seem to be suffering from a lack of joy. If that doesn't reflect how you feel these days, praise the Lord. But if it does, then you won't want to miss this short series on Defeating Despair, Restoring Hope, and Seeking Joy. We will let God's Word reveal what's going on in our world and in our own hearts this month as we explore these issues. Everything we do at FBC is intended to help you discover and grow in faith. It's my sincere hope that when you read this newsletter and see everything going on that you see it as a menu of options to choose from, not an overwhelming list of obligations. I'm excited for what God is doing in your life through the ministry of FBC. I hope you'll find exactly what you need as we pursue Christ together.
