"Go, make disciples...." ~ Matthew 28:19

It may surprise some people, but the command in the great commission is not "to go". The typical translation is "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations..." The word for "go" in the original language would be better translated, "as you go" or "wherever you happen to go" or "as you are going". The command is to make disciples, and the implication is that everyone can and should do this wherever they go, or wherever they happen to be. Over the next few months we are going to learn what "discipleship" means. Here's a hint, it's the state of being a disciple. As we kick off this new series we are bringing in a discipleship expert. Bill Allison has dedicated his life and ministry to the disciple-making He founded a ministry called Cadre process. Missionaries, which helps teach and train people how to be disciples who make disciples who make disciples, ad infinitum... you get the idea. He will be preaching on October 2nd to introduce the idea of

disciple making. Then, on October 8th Bill will return for a conference/workshop/training that will help us to dig a little deeper into the disciple making life. After that we will spend the next several months learning all the things the Bible says about what it means to live the Christian life and how to grow into the kind of disciples Jesus called us to be. A disciple is someone who learns from Jesus and follows Him in order to be more like Him. Thankfully we have the amazing gift of the Holy Spirit that helps us in the process and the great gift of grace that means no matter how slow we are to learn or how often we fail. God continually forgives us and sees us as His children. I'm excited to see how God grows us into disciples and disciple makers over the next few weeks and months. If you haven't signed up for the discipleship training, it's not too late do so. We'd love to have everyone possible join us for a fun and important time together next Saturday.

Refuge Student Ministry




<u>Refuge</u> is a great place to gather with friends, play games, have snacks, and dig into God's Word! Invite your friends to join us!
