

I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore I have continued my faithfulness to you. ~ Jeremiah 31:3b

Love is a choice. Love is a feeling. The two are so closely related that they can be said to be intertwined. They build and feed off of one another. They reciprocate. In John it tells us that God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son. His affection for His creation compelled Him to act. Jesus defined love in this way, that there is no greater love (in existence) than this, that someone would lay down their life for those they love. The volition, or action, proves the extent of the feeling. So, when God defines how we ought to understand love, He says, if you love Me, you will obey My Word (John 14:15). The Bible also tells us where love originates, where it comes from; we love because He first loved us (1 John 4:19). So, not only is love reciprocal, but it is responsive or reactionary. We feel more love and affection as a response to the clear and obvious sense of God's love for us.

The point is this; God loves us. He has spoken His love, and proved it with His self-sacrificing action by sending His

own Son to die on the cross on our behalf. He has invited us to love Him back. Responding to God's love will require three things (at least). The first is to act. Responding to God through obedience. Agreeing with God about sin, forgiveness, and growing to become more Christlike. The second thing should flow naturally from the first. We will grow in our affection for Christ. As our relationship with God grows (through obedience), our heart follows our action. The third thing that happens is that our love for others grows. Because God loves others and we are seeking to agree with God more and more, our love for others has to be the result. This follows the same pattern. It's a choice. We act. We make a choice to treat others in right and respectful ways out of respect for God. As we do this more and more, our care and enjoyment of others should be the natural result.

February is the month we celebrate and focus on love. My prayer is that we grow in love this month. It starts with God and thankfully, it never stops.

Refuge Student Ministry








