

"When I saw Him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But He laid his right hand on me, saying, "Fear not, I am the first and the last, and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore." ~ Revelation 1:17-18

A couple weeks ago I was in Nicaragua on a mission trip with a group of students and a few adults. When we stepped off the bus to walk into the airport in Chicago it was about 17 degrees. When we stepped off the plane in Managua it was in the mid 80's and very humid. It felt great. As the week went on, I realized how unaccustomed I was to the heat and humidity. I was tired. When we got back to Illinois it was as cold as when we left. But I didn't mind. I knew spring was right around the corner and it gave me a chance to appreciate the change of seasons. In Nicaragua there are only two seasons. Hot & dry and hot & rainy. The change of seasons is always a reminder of new life. We start seeing robins, the grass gets green, the sun comes out and we start thinking about doing outdoor activities that don't include shoveling snow.

For us spring is more than just the hope of warmer weather, it's a celebration of the resurrection. We live with the knowledge that our Lord is alive. He spent three days in the tomb and walked out never to die again. Our salvation is based on that fact. We celebrate the resurrection of Christ each spring not only in recognition of the victory He won over death, but also because His resurrection was a promise and a prophecy about our own eternal life. Jesus said in John 14:19 "Because I live, you also will live." In some way what we celebrate is not just Jesus's life in Himself (His power to defeat death), but Jesus's life in us (His willingness to share that power with us). In turn, we are able to shed our greatest fear (of death), and live confidently and joyfully. It's true that in this world we will have trouble, but it is also true that we can take heart, because our Lord has overcome the world. In light of that, we are also told that we are more than conquerors in Christ. So we are not merely going to observe Easter, we are going to celebrate our risen Lord this spring and always.






Iron Sharpens Iron Men's Event
