For some people it may be hard to understand why a sabbatical would be necessary. All I can say is that it's not physical rest that is needed, I know many people work much harder jobs than we do. It's the weight of ministry that requires some relief. There is a spiritual taxation that accumulates which pastors experience that is hard to comprehend. It's a sense of responsibility that what is being done is not only important but has eternal significance. That what is said has to be accurate because we represent not ourselves, but the Lord and we are accountable to Him. The sense that there are 500-600 people connected to the ministry of FBC that we feel a certain responsibility for their spiritual well-being. I am not complaining. I am overwhelmed with gratitude that God would call me to do such wonderful work.

The need for a sabbatical is not just a reprieve from the weight of ministry, but also a readjustment spiritually. At some point it is important to spend time with God as a Christian and not as a pastor. Being a pastor drives me closer to God, and I appreciate that, but it's also a good thing to remember that I am a Christian first, a husband and father, and somewhere down the list, yes, I'm a pastor. Sometimes the pastor identity gets too high on the list. It's going to be interesting. This is new to me. In a lot of ways this is kind of an experiment. Regardless, I'm confident in a couple things. One, we will be refreshed and ready when August comes. And two, the church is in good hands. There are so many people who love FBC and are invested in the people who call our church home that I have no worries. The staff, the leaders, and the volunteers are more than ready and able to do everything needed to have a great summer reaching Mercer County with the gospel. In the meantime, you'll be seeing the Dunns here or there, and we look forward to being back together in August.
