<u>High School Refuge</u> – High School students (9th-12th grade) will meet every Sunday in July from 6:00-8:00pm, doors open at 5:45pm.



J.O.Y. Circle is for women of all ages. No need to RSVP to J.O.Y. Circle, just show up!






Join us for Ladies Night Out!


