This is Seth. As you read this, I'm praying that you are challenged, encouraged and strengthened by Jesus Christ. I'm a big fan of the Word of God so when two or three witnesses of a matter is shown to me, I know God is going to established a matter.

was \$600 for the building fund to start a "loaves and fishes" contribution. They gave \$100 per loaf and \$50 per fish. They were both made with good dough. LOL! As I shared the envelope story and the scripture, it was at that point that someone told me about #3. I learned that after Sunday's sermon God laid the building project on their heart and they gave money. I could clearly see and it still causes me to rejoice.

God is on the move to build something here at FBC. To me, He is building our hearts to trust Him and to keep striving together in unity. It's not all about what we build, where we build, how we build or why we build but <u>it is all about WHO</u> is building because unless the Lord builds it, we will labor in vain. God is establishing this build so let us rejoice together that He is moving and He is working in the heart of this Church to be on His team and come and see what He is doing. ALL ABOARD!

When you look over this Newsletter and see our budget and that we are above giving, don't stop giving! All the above and beyond portion is getting set aside for the building fund. Every dime every penny matters. When Jesus is in the mix and he has our hearts, WATCH OUT!?! With God, nothing is impossible! It is so much fun to see God just doing His thing. AMAZING!!!
