

What I learned on Sabbatical

There were three big lessons I learned this summer from the sabbatical. They can be summed up with the words: appreciation, encouragement, and enjoyment.

Appreciation: As a pastor I have one great benefit, and one great burden. The Benefit is that my job/calling enables me to spend massive amounts of time with the Lord in prayer, Bible study, and fellowship with other believers. Not only am I able to do this, I am expected to. In the same way, I have a tremendous sense of moral accountability because of my leadership role. In other words, my role as a pastor helps keep me walking closely with the Lord. The Burden of ministry is the relentless spiritual battle that is inseparable from the weight of responsibility of leading people to deeper faith in Christ. During the sabbatical, I was learning about connecting with the Lord without an agenda. In some ways it was like being a new Christian. I was still motivated to spend time with God every day, but in a different way than I had for years. I appreciate, more than ever, how much discipline and dedication it requires to maintain a growing relationship with Christ, especially for those who aren't paid to do so.

Encouragement: I was most encouraged by the health and strength of our church. The sabbatical was always going to be a testing time for the church. I knew it was a potential risk to step away for three months, but I also believed two things: 1- I needed it, and 2- the church needed it. I needed to disengage from the stress of pastoring. But, just as important, the church needed to experience the reality that we really are healthy and capable of doing great ministry with or without the Dunns. We are so encouraged to see how well the church did without us.

Enjoyment: Last of all, I was reminded of something important. Ministry should be enjoyable. Each Sunday we would attend a different church, and it was great simply to show up, enjoy the morning and leave refreshed. Sometimes I take my job so seriously that I forget to enjoy the fact that I get paid to serve the Lord and bless people. So, I've been enjoying what I do, even though I still take it seriously... The Lord showed me that preaching/teaching is His way of keeping me desperately close to Him, but that I also need to have fun with it.

One last thing... When I say that I am encouraged by the health of our church, there was something specific that happened that proved it to me. We had a town hall meeting at the end of July to discuss the building plans/options. Everyone I've talked to said how good that meeting was. The outcome of the meeting was a real sense of unity and purpose for FBC's future. The building committee felt there was a clear directive to pursue a building plan that included a sanctuary and children's ministry area on the new property as the first stage of development with future expansion for youth, offices, adult classrooms, and a fellowship hall to be considered for future stages. It has been exciting to see how God is moving through this process. Keep praying as we keep seeking God's will for what He has planned for us. Big things are coming!

KIDS CLUB MINISTRY



Do you have card making supplies just sitting around not getting used? Would you enjoy making cards to share with others? Talk to Britni Ewing about helping with the card ministry!






What Is Wednesday Night Live?

Men's Momentum at Life Action Camp! Oct. 27th-29th - Buchanan, MI



FBC Building Committee Update

In response to the overwhelming support of the congregation at the last town hall meeting, the building committee has recommended that FBC terminate our lease agreement, and no longer plant crops on the future building site. The church council voted unanimously to approve the recommendation. FBC will no longer be receiving \$3,000 annually for rent on the new property. It is our hope and desire to begin to prepare the property for ministry use. It was also recommended that a capital campaign committee be formed to begin raising money in earnest for the new building. Designations for the building fund are welcome and encouraged.
