She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.” ~ Matthew 1:21

It's amazing. Sometimes I can hardly believe it. I shouldn't be surprised, but I am. I can't help it. I see new faces every week. The church is full. Last week there was a family that came in a little after the service had started and I was looking around for some empty seats, and wasn't sure where they were going to sit. They found seats. Maybe someone was saving a spot for them. More people have been attending the 8am service too. It seems like people really understand that we have to make room so we can keep growing. As we approach Christmas there are two things to remember. Christmas is about the Gospel. I know that seems obvious, but the truth is that in all the business and celebration, it's easy to forget that the birth of Jesus was 100% about salvation. God's plan of saving people from their sins had finally arrived. The savior had been expected and prophesied from the moment sin was introduced into the world. Genesis records God declaring that the seed of the woman would crush the head of the serpent. This is referred to as the protoevangelium, or the first declaration of the Gospel. When Jesus was born it was the fulfillment of thousands of years of hopeful expectation.

There is another thing we remember during the Christmas season, which is making room. The story of Jesus's birth is framed by “no more room” and “making room in a stable”. A very humble beginning for the king and creator of the universe who is born not only to save humanity, but to be the Lord and Judge of all creation for eternity. But room was made and a beautiful story is retold every year in its honor. We need to make room. We need to make room for others. We need to make room for faith. Making room for others may be as simple as being patient when traffic gets busy and lines get long. It may be inviting someone to church, or, when others have guests at church to happily sit somewhere different (or attend a different service). Making room for faith is an effort to keep Christ as the center and reason for the season. It might include a church service, even when family pressures make it easier to skip. Or it may include spending some time in the Bible and prayer before digging into a meal or opening presents. The holiday season will come and go like a blur. But they will be so much more meaningful and memorable if we keep Jesus at the center of it.

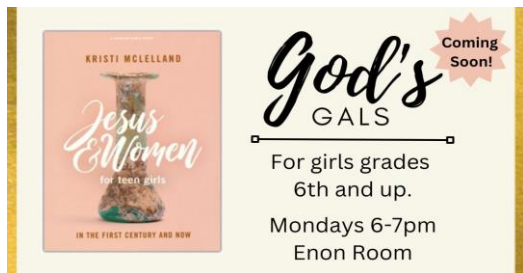
Refuge Student Ministry

Boom Sisters – No Boom Sisters in December. We'll see you in 2024!

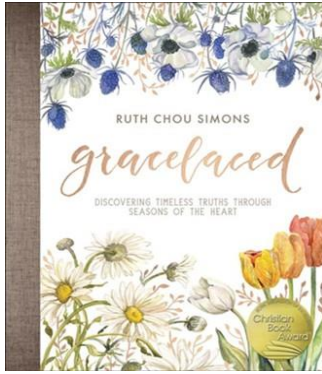

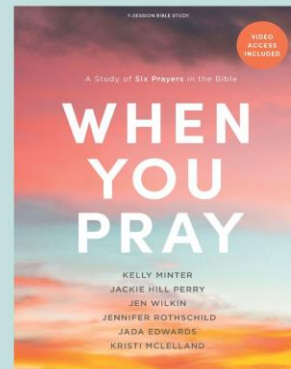
