People may be curious about what happened at our last business meeting. We had said that we would discuss possible changes to our Sunday morning worship schedule in the October meeting. Everything we've been working on, from the 10 acres of land we purchased, to the building committee working on plans for additional space, and making changes to our worship schedule are all intended to do one thing... reach Mercer County with the Gospel. The downside is that kids don't get to worship with their families, and the church doesn't get to see how many kids God has blessed us with each week. Our hope is that with a new sanctuary in the foreseeable future, there would be plenty of space for family worship. What's so exciting is that we have such good problems to deal with. Trying to keep up with God's blessing is a good problem. I'm even more excited that there is such a spirit of unity. We have plenty of challenges to overcome, but we are unified in our hearts and minds. The Bible said that unity in the church is by the name of Jesus. He is our leader and our focus and our purpose. We take our direction from Him. Keep praying. Pray for more people to come to Christ and come to church. Pray for the building committee. Pray for unity. Pray for the leaders and volunteers to stay focused and energized. Pray for God's Spirit to move in Mercer County. Pray for the funds needed to do what we need to do. Pray for God to show you what part He has for you in everything He's doing at First Baptist.

Practice has started and will continue each week through Dec. 3rd. We hope you will join us for this special Christmas service.


Refuge Student Ministry


