






Refuge Student Ministry







Men's Ministry Kicks Off 2024!

The Men's Ministry has begun planning for the 2024 event calendar. There are three events already scheduled that you may want to add to your calendar. On February 9th there will be a bags tournament at the church, more details to follow.

March 2nd we will have a group attending Iron Sharpens Iron at Coram Deo Church in Davenport, IA. The keynote speakers are; Rev. **Dr. Don Davis** is the Executive Director of the Urban Ministry Institute and Sr. vice president of Church Resources for World Impact. and Dr. Chris Harper (aka Harp) is passionate about biblical manhood, and often speaks on topics such as a man's identity in Christ, the trouble and trials that threaten men, and the importance of being a gospel-centered husband and father. ISI is a oneday event. We will carpool to Davenport and return around 5pm that evening. Registration opens in January. Cost, including lunch, for early bird registration (by Feb. 18th) is \$59 for adults and \$43 for students ages 13-22.

Then, on July 20th, our annual Men's Rooted Conference is scheduled with Tom Harmon as our guest speaker. Tom draws upon his 11 years as a State Patrol Officer and as a college athlete to illustrate God's work in his life. In 1984, he sensed God's call to preach, resigned from the state police, pastored a small church for four years, and then became a full-time itinerant preacher. Tom has led numerous Momentum weekends at Life Action Camp in Buchanan, MI.
