

"Where there is no vision, the people perish." - Proverbs 29:18 (KJV)

On Sunday February 4th we are planning "Vision Sunday." It is, in many ways, the beginning and the end of a long process. It's the end or at least the culmination of many years of discernment, meetings, prayers, discussions, and plans of the FBC building committee. We've run into so many roadblocks over the years it would take a long time to even explain. There have been plans upon plans upon plans to expand our building, most of which seemed like a good solution, but never quite the right solution. Personally, it has been very frustrating, discouraging, and at times it has made me question my own leadership ability. Two years ago something changed. By God's goodness, grace and flawless timing FBC was able to purchase some much-needed land. It is separated from our current location only by the width of 7th Avenue. From that point on we have been reconsidering everything. As a result, the building project began to look at a bigger picture. What does the future of FBC look like on a 13.5-acre campus (3.5 acres of our current location plus 10 acres across the street)? On Vision Sunday we will present what we believe that picture looks like. Which means that Vision Sunday is the beginning of another long process. We will begin laying out in detail the plans, asking lots of

questions, answering those questions, raising money, and eventually seek a commitment from our church body. We will undergo a feasibility study that will help us determine if we have the financial ability to do the project and the support necessary to see it through. By the beginning of the summer, sometime in mid-June, we should be ready to vote. After that, the work begins.

I shared a passage from Proverbs, "where there is no vision the people perish..." that is the King James Version translation. It is typically used to promote church visions. Or, in most cases, misused to promote the idea that we need to come up with a vision that people will get excited about. The literal translation of that passage is closer to "where there is no (biblical, prophetic) revelation, the people cast off restraint (become disobedient and rebellious), but blessed is he who keeps the law (follows God's Word). The point that the Proverb is making is much more closely related to Psalm 119... "God's Word is a lamp unto my feet and light unto my path (when we follow it, we don't stumble)." I've never been good at promoting man-made visions. I don't know what the future holds or what it's going to look like. What I do know is that when we honor God and follow His Word, He is pleased and pours out His blessing. I also believe that FBC has a unique role and opportunity in spreading the Gospel to Mercer County. And I believe that we need more space to be able to reach more people. Our responsibility is to follow and teach God's Word. We continue to do that with the focus on reaching every heart in Mercer County for Christ. We are here to see lost people saved, and saved people grow. So, we are focused on outreach. We want to

<u>Refuge Student Ministry</u>-Refuge is for students grades 6th-12th, and we meet on Sundays from 6-8pm.







Wednesday Night Live Jan. 24th – March 20th



What's Coming Up For The Men!


The Men's Ministry has a couple of events coming up in early February and March and an event in July that you will want to put on your calendar.

On Friday, February 2nd there will be a Men's Bags Tournament at the church. The event begins at 6pm with pizza and soda provided. You are asked to bring your favorite bag of chips or package of cookies to be shared. Bring your own partner or let us pick a partner for you. All men 13 years and older are welcome for this fun and fellowship event. On March 2nd we will have a group attending Iron Sharpens Iron at Coram Deo Church in Davenport, IA. The keynote speakers are **Rev. Dr. Don Davis** is the Executive Director of the Urban Ministry Institute and Sr. vice president of Church Resources for World Impact, and **Dr. Chris Harper** (aka Harp) is passionate about biblical manhood, and often speaks on topics such as a man's identity in Christ, the trouble and trials that threaten men, and the importance of being a gospel-centered husband and father. ISI is a one-day event. Early bird registration has begun. You can sign up online. The cost is \$59 for adults and \$43 for students (13 -22 years old). Prices go up to \$79 and \$63 on February 18th. We will carpool to Davenport, leaving the Church at 7:15am and returning around 5pm that evening.

Then on July 20th, our annual Rooted Conference is scheduled with Tom Harmon as our guest speaker. Tom draws upon his 11 years as a State Patrol Officer and as a college athlete to illustrate God's work in his life. In 1984, he sensed God's call to preach, resigned from the state police, pastored a small church for four years, and then became a full-time itinerant preacher. Tom has led numerous Momentum Weekends at Life Action Camp in Buchanan MI. Watch for details and sign up coming in the spring.




