

#### "Come and see ... " ~ John 1:39

As I write, snow is still falling and the ground is covered I don't think it will last, but it's hard to believe Easter is right around the corner. It's always an exciting time of the year. This year our theme is "Come and See." John the Baptist had just told his disciples that Jesus was the lamb of God who would take away the sins of the world. The disciples seem too nervous to question Jesus about His lordship, so instead they ask Him where He is staying. His reply is simply, "come and see." Our hope is that the way we live our lives, the way we worship as a church, and the way we love and trust God, is worthy to be seen and experienced and convincing enough to cause others to want to put their faith in Jesus too. Come and see is a non-threatening invitation to observe and experience the power of God in action. Initially, it doesn't require a choice or a commitment. It's simply an open door. We believe that the Psalm is true that declares, "taste and see how good the Lord is." Not only that, but it would seem that many people believe with their heart and experience before they believe with their minds. C.S. Lewis is famously quoted as saying that if a person can be argued into believing they can be argued into doubting. So, we invite everyone to come and see. See how good God is and

how much He cares for you. We want to show people as well as teach them. I think Rick Warren said people don't care how much you know until they know how much you care. Hopefully we care a lot (and know a lot too).

Come and see has also been a theme for our vision for FBC. We've presented a big vision for our future, and have worked for a month to hear back from our congregation about questions, concerns, hopeful expectations and blind spots that we need to know about. In the next week or so we will share the results of the feasibility study with you and answer every question that has been asked. It's exciting to see how unified and positive our church has been in the process. No matter what we decide, we want to be a good witness to those watching and listening. When they come and see what we believe and how we handle life in all its complexity and uncertainty, their faith should grow. That's our hope, and if ever there was a time to hope, this is it.
