

Frequently Asked Questions... Building and Capital Campaign

A few weeks ago we were given a report from Church Growth Services (CGS). We had spent a few weeks unveiling the vision for First Baptist Church and the building that we believe will enable us to do the best ministry possible both now and in the future. On Vision Sunday we spoke of the process, the reasons and the plan for the new building. The following Sunday we spent the Sunday School hour discussing the vision and collecting thoughts, opinions, and questions. We sent out about 100 emails to leaders in our church with more specific questions, and a small group of people were selected to respond to a phone interview with CGS. Last of all, we had the entire church fill out a survey about the vision. All that information was collected by CGS, collated, interpreted, and returned to FBC in the form of a 40-page report and a one-page synopsis. Here are some of the takeaways:

- The church is very supportive of the building plan that was proposed.
 - Over 70% agreement, with almost 20% undecided. We believe this means that the more details are given and questions are answered the undecided will give support.
 - Nearly 75% agree that a capital campaign should begin and that they are committed to give financial support, with about 15% undecided. Again, we believe that the undecided will give support once more information is available.

- The church is spiritually and financially healthy enough to support the project.
 - FBC has a very good distribution of age groups actively involved.
 - FBC has a great distribution of tenure, half our church has attended for more than 10 years and half has attended for less than 10 years. Meaning that we are stable but growing.
 - FBC has a strong giving ratio. On average, FBC attenders give at the 6% level. This means we exceed the average in America by almost 4%, but still have room to improve.
- There were questions, but no surprises.
 - The frequently asked questions were:
 - What is the plan for the current building?
 - What is the plan for the youth ministry?
 - What is the plan for crossing the street?
 - How will we afford the project?

We are still working on solutions to all these questions, and we will be answering them as best and as soon as we can. In the next month or so we will be working hard with the building committee and the capital campaign committee to get all the information to the church body that you need. The capital campaign is already underway. Please be in prayer. We believe this building project is the next step to enable FBC to reach many more people for Christ. It will take our whole church prayerfully and generously supporting it to see it happen. Together, with God's help we can make the vision come to life.

This Winter Spring Session of Kids Club has wrapped up.



Refuge Student Ministry








