

And He said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to every creature." ~ Mark 16:15

A group of 16 adults began arriving to the church shortly after 3am on Saturday April 13th. We loaded up the church bus with our luggage, said a prayer and began to make our way to the Moline airport in those dark early hours. About 9 hours later we were stepping off the plane in El Salvador in sweltering humidity which is the constant climate so close to the equator. We spent a week offering the gospel to kids and parents through an hour-long program filled with acting, story-telling, and singing assisted by interpreters. At each mission we intentionally spent time with the local leaders, sharing a meal and hearing their stories. We wanted to know how God had called them to serve the way they were serving, and to let them know that we truly cared for them and the work they were doing. Before we left we gathered around and prayed blessings of strength and protection over each leader. As the week closed we spent an evening with the leaders of the main church we work with in Montelemar. There were around 20 leaders present. We shared some teaching, encouragement and testimonies, and we invited them to share their own stories with us. A group of 16 adults made their way to the El Salvador airport around 4am on Friday April 19th. About 16 hours later we began to load our luggage on the church bus and make our way home. We were a little tired, some were sick, but somehow amazingly blessed.

We go to El Salvador to proclaim the gospel to every creature. It's important that we see what that means in other cultures, lands and languages. We call it "missions". When we do the same at home we call it "ministry". Lately, I have been describing our "ministry" to consultants, bankers and non-profit agencies as we work on the vision, building project and capital campaign. As I describe what we do, I am amazed and encouraged. Everything we do is for the community. We have as many children attending our programs who belong to other churches or no church at all as we do from our own church body. That is not an accident. We are community-minded and our heart is for outreach. We want every creature to hear the gospel and that means we open our doors wide. We teach God's Word unashamedly, and we present God's grace freely. We invite and welcome any and all to join us and we go out and serve our community every chance we get. From Helping Hands Service projects, to hosting Kids Zone at Rhubarb Fest, to Praise in the Park Family Fest, and after school programs, to Family Night at the Y, and on and on it goes. We spend long hours planning and preparing and serving, exhausting ourselves every bit as much as a team of missionaries to get the gospel to every creature in Mercer County. It's a ministry and it's a mission, and it's what we are all doing together as the First Baptist Church. Thanks for your help in making it possible.







Refuge Student Ministry

<u>Boomsisters</u> - All 6th-12th grade girls invited to join us here at the church on Saturday, May 11th from 10am-11:30am. Sign up online!




