

And your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it," when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left. ~ Isaiah 30:21

We are always moving into the unknown. We can know the past, and be aware of the present, but the future is always a mystery. In the prophecy of Isaiah, the Lord had revealed that His people would be given the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, but that God would still be with them. As they moved into an unknown future, they would hear a voice from behind guiding them, keeping them from straying off the path. We often feel the same way. We would prefer to know exactly what lies ahead and plan for it accordingly, but that's not how it works. Instead we do two things, we seek wisdom and faithfulness, and we trust that God will be with us and guide us into His will. Last week we revealed the results of the capital campaign on Celebration Sunday. 1.1 Million dollars was committed by our church body for the building of the facility and the building of the kingdom. While that's a wonderful amount of money, the results were not quite as good as we had hoped. We have a vision for a new building with a larger sanctuary, secure kids' ministry area, and a spacious lobby. Our capital

campaign was the first step in moving towards that future. While the capital campaign has concluded, the process of fundraising has only just begun. We will need to discuss and prayerfully discern the vision that has been laid out. In the spirit of Isaiah, are we still on the path? Is the Lord correcting our course? Is there something we are missing? What's the next step?

In the meantime, we ask for prayer and patience. This may be a slower process than we imagined. There is a business meeting in July, and I expect that we will be discussing many of the items that have come up over the past few months through the course of the capital campaign. I don't know if a decision will be made at that point, or if it's even possible to make a decision. From the beginning of this process I believed we had been given a direction not a decision. As we continue to seek the Lord for wisdom and guidance, we need to listen closely to His voice to know if we're still going in the right direction. It's important that we move forward in unity, but it's even more important that we go where God leads us. That can only happen if we are seeking Him first and foremost. That's my prayer for all of us in the months ahead.

This is a free, family event (all ages can participate) and we ask that a teen/adult be present to supervise kiddos.



Take Me Out To The Ball Park!


The FBC Men's Ministry is sponsoring A Night at the Ball Park during the QC River Bandits Faith & Family Event.
