



"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." ~ 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Thanksgiving is behind us, but being thankful is never out of season. In fact, Scripture teaches that it is the expressed and clear will of God for every Christian person to be thankful and rejoice continually. There are two things that I believe are necessary to build a thankful spirit like this. 1 Thessalonians reveals not only a call or command, but also the process of how to do it. The first thing we need to do is rejoice. This seems to be a choice we make to praise, worship, and thank God for everything and anything we value in our lives. It's natural to rejoice when something good happens in our lives. I remember feeling so overwhelmed with joy, love and gratitude when each of our daughters were born. That's natural. It's supernatural to rejoice in ordinary, or even unpleasant circumstances.

The second thing 1 Thessalonians teaches us is to pray continually. This is what we call "walking in the Spirit". It indicates that even though we are responsible for our choices and have some ability to choose our behavior, that our biggest need is to be transformed by the power and presence of God. In other words, a thankful, rejoicing heart is developed by spending time with God. The more

we pray, the more God's goodness, love and joy will affect us. This is not hard to understand. The people we spend the most time with have the most impact on how we think, feel and act. Scripture calls us to not only be careful who we allow to influence us in our daily lives, but to make sure above all we spend lots of time with God to allow Him to influence us the most.

This Christmas season I hope a spirit of thanksgiving will be evident throughout our church. The third teaching in 1 Thessalonians on this issue tells us that rejoicing and thanksgiving ought to be done "in all circumstances". The holiday season is one of the most complicated times of year to talk about rejoicing. For many people it is easy. There is such a happy anticipation of everything the season offers that there is no need to even speak of rejoicing. But for many people this season is the hardest time of the year. Pain, loss, grief, and loneliness can be overwhelming. Rejoicing and thanksgiving are sometimes done in light of circumstances, and sometimes in spite of circumstances. The focus of our joy is not the circumstance, but the God who loves us in every circumstance. It is His will that we rejoice. Why? Because it is His will that we experience joy and peace in every season.




### Refuge Student Ministry





### 2025 Women's Flourish Small Groups New Study for 2025


