On March 9th Mollie and I announced that the Lord had called us to serve Him somewhere new. It was a very difficult and emotional announcement to make, and even more difficult and emotional to wrestle with the calling over the years. We have received nothing but kindness and support in response to the announcement. People have questions, which is understandable. A call to ministry is somewhat different than most other vocations. I understood my call to ministry when I was about 23 years old. At that time, I only knew that God was calling me to serve Him in ministry, but I still didn't know how or where that call would lead me. God has always been good to me. He led me to Mollie, and that has been the greatest blessing in my life. He led us every step of the way from Kansas to Illinois, to First Baptist, and now to Pennsylvania. Sometimes we rest in the call and know that we are exactly where God wants us to be and doing what He wants us to do. At other times we wrestle with that call, not sure if we are supposed to stay

or go, and if He's calling us to go, where is He calling? We go through seasons of intense prayer and discernment seeking answers. There will be a challenging season ahead for First Baptist, but it will be good. The process of coming together to deeply seek God's will and prayerfully ask for His wisdom and direction can produce fruit that can't be produced any other way. I'm excited for all that God is going to do. It's hard to say goodbye, but there is nothing better than knowing we are secure in God's will.




