Building Committee Update:

With Pastor Luke and Mollie prayerfully answering the call that God has put on their hearts, the building committee has decided to take a "pause". I use the word pause because we are still praying for The Lord's direction and His timing. We still believe that he has something in store for us in regards to our building needs, but we are praying for Him to reveal exactly what that plan is. We are currently in uncharted waters and waiting for His guidance in this situation. We don't yet know if that will be waiting until a new Senior Pastor has been called or if He will reveal His plan before that time. We will continue to be in prayer and ask that you all do the same. In the meantime, I would ask that if you have thoughts or suggestions feel free to reach out to myself or one of the other members of the Building Committee.


FBC Administrator Update:

When Pastor Luke announced he would be moving on from our church, I felt The Spirit immediately telling me that I would have to step up in some way. I didn't know what He meant at the time, but after a lot of prayer and wise council, it was revealed to myself and others that the staff and Pastor Seth specifically would need someone to help with the administrative duties at the church. Pastor Luke was an amazing Senior Pastor and had an immense amount of responsibilities that many people may not have even recognized. Pastor Seth and I discussed how best to fill those shoes and presented a plan to the Church Council at a meeting in March. The Council approved that Pastor Seth would continue filling his current role as Associate Pastor and all the responsibilities that it entails as well as taking the reins in regards to leading the spiritual direction of our church.

It was also decided that I would temporarily step into the role of Church Administrator. What exactly this role looks like will be determined over the next several months as needs arise. Currently, I have been meeting with the staff weekly (or more often) to ensure that their needs are being met. I have been assisting with workload balancing, staffing decisions, staff coaching, decision making in regards to budgets, time off, purchases, etc. Over the next several months, I will be developing some procedures for staff reviews as well as beginning the process of reviewing our Church Constitution, By Laws, and Standing Rules. At some point, the need will likely arise to appoint a committee to look into all these things, but I would like to take some time and really digest all of these documents and discern what direction The Lord is leading us as a church. Also, I'm planning to meet with each board and committee to get a better feel of their roles and responsibilities.

As we wade forward into this pool of unknown, my prayer is for all of us to feel The Lord's Spirit washing over all of us. He is in control of this situation and His Will Be Done! I am happy to meet with any of you and answer any questions that I can. At this time, I am not maintaining "regular" hours at the church, but will typically be in the office on Thursdays and otherwise available as needed by the staff and the church body. Rhubarb Fest!

Hey church family, we will be selling pie by the slice at this year's Aledo Rhubarb Fest on Friday, June 6th to help fund two approaching activities for our youth and young adults. We have a few high schoolers that will be leaving for a Mission trip June 13th-20th, 2025 in Ohio, and we have a small group of young adults that will be attending a conference in January 2026. We are asking for your help in a variety of ways:



Rhubarb growers - If you have been blessed with a rhubarb crop this year and would like to share, we are asking for at least 35 – 1 gallon size bags filled with cut (1" pieces) and washed rhubarb. Please bring the fresh (not frozen) Rhubarb to the church between May 29th-June 1st, and place it in the basement refrigerator. If you have the rhubarb and would like someone else to harvest it for you, then just let us know!

Seasoned Rhubarb Pie Makers – We are looking for 3 seasoned rhubarb pie makers to impart their wisdom of rhubarb pie making to some of our youth on Wednesday, June 4th, and possibly Thursday, June 5th. We will be using premade Amish crusts this year but need your skills to teach us how to make and assemble these pies. Those with an Oven – We are looking for volunteers within our church to pick up pies throughout the day on Wednesday June 4th, and possibly Thursday, June 5th to bake them. It will take about an hour to an hour and half for two pies. Free smells are included!

Packaging Partners – We would love to have a few volunteers on Thursday, June 5th to help with cutting and packaging the pie slices. Laughter and wonderful conversation will be included.
