

### **Pastor's Perspective**

"GO" - Isaiah 6:8

As we gear up for the fall, I am continually reminded that I did not grow up in a midwestern state. Here are a few examples. If you have ever put ski gear on underneath a costume for Trick or Treating, you might live in the Midwest. If you have ever stood outside in your wife's robe to see a category five tornado take your neighbor's mailbox, you might live in the Midwest. I get this constant reminder from God that, though I am not built for the Midwest, it is where God has called me. And to think if I wasn't faithful in the big decisions of my life, how could God expect me to take care of all the blessings I have now? Like my beautiful wife, my amazing son, and the home He's provided for both. All I had to do was say, "I will go, Lord. Send me," and He did all of the rest. I am not saying that He will get you that Lamborghini, or pay off your mortgage, but what would happen if Jesus were asking you to do something, and you were to say,

"YES LORD, SEND ME"? In this passage in Isaiah, God is asking Isaiah, "Whom should I send as a messenger to these people? Who will go for us?" and come on, who else would God be talking to in this moment? And yet it is still on the decision of Isaiah to be used by God for God. What work is God trying to bless you with? I know work isn't something that we think of as a blessing very often, but when you look in scripture, it was a gift to Adam even before the FALL....Eh? Eh? Come on, guys, that's funny. Where is God asking you to go next? What would be brought to your table if you were to say "Yes"? I don't know the answers to that, but I can tell you from my experience and from the experience of Isaiah that you will never regret it. You just have to trust in the Lord, and He will set the paths of our lives straight (Proverbs 3:5). Here at this church, we are in need of people who can and will be used by God. That means you. He doesn't call the equipped, He equips the called. How will God use you this Fall? And why haven't you said "yes" yet?














# REFUGE STUDENT MINISTRY
